



Local blogger, Asma from Jet Set Chick shares her top five iftar tips at intu Trafford Centre

1. Arrive early

There's nothing worse than rushing around just before meal time especially when you've been fasting. You don't have to worry about parking stress at intu Trafford Centre, but arriving early means you could indulge in some retail therapy before making your way to The Orient.

2. Book a table

Call ahead and reserve a table at least fifteen minutes before you are due to break your fast. This gives you enough time to sit down, get settled and place your orders. Be sure to mention to the staff that you are fasting and request some tap water straight away.

3. Sneak in some early Eid shopping


Shopping is a good way of taking your mind off eating, but it'll encourage you to stay on your feet and not fall into the trap of living on the sofa for a month.

4. Prayer facilities are available

For those who wish to perform their prayers or perhaps spend some time reflecting before it's time to eat, intu Trafford Centre has a multi faith room just by Debenhams.

5. Don't overdo it

Try and see through the hunger haze and base your order on your normal portion size, or slightly less. The food court at intu Trafford Centre is open until late so you don't need to order a huge feast all at once. I would recommend ordering a starter and a main, and not asking for it all to arrive together.


